Yes, University Park has confirmed nymphs of the Spotted Lanternfly (SLF). We have all heard all the warnings on how invasive this insect is and how much damage it can do, especially to those tresses already suffering from other problems.

Mode of Transportation

The Spotted Lanternfly is transported from other areas on cars, campers, trucks, wood for camps to name a few.

How harmful are they?

- They can kill a branch or the whole tree
- Cause damage to a tree inviting other insects to do more harm
- Cause visible damage now which the tree could possibly recover from next year

To Prevent Loss and/or Damage
